Junior A Mariners Game Protocols

Spectator Fundamentals (2 Zones):

- Seats are organized into two separated zones of approximately 200 Seats
 - **Zone 1** will enter and exit through the main Entrance with washrooms in upper lobby
 - **Zone 2** will enter and exit through the West End Stairs with washrooms on West Concourse
- Wheelchair accessible seats are available in Zone 1
- Contact tracing will be captured at purchase
- Doors open at 7:00PM, 30 minutes before game time
- Masks are to be worn at all times inside the Mariners Centre except when consuming food or beverage
- Main floor lobby washrooms are committed to Arena 2 activity
- No standing room on concourse or at rink-side
- Spectators will be able to enter & exit at intermission if necessary
- Arena 2 and certain areas of Arena 1 will not be accessible to Junior A spectators

<p>Zones of 200 Spectators</p>	<p>Tickets: A maximum of 200 tickets will be sold in each Zone, up to a maximum of 3 Zones Spectator Zone specifics are communicated at purchase based on section number, in addition to key event information like dedicated entry and washroom access</p> <p>Access: Access to the building will be granted only to those with a ticket to the game or those supporting the event (for which contact tracing has been captured)</p> <p>Entry/Exit: Each Zone will have a dedicated Entry/Exit point based on the section of the seat they have been dedicated. Ticket takers and ushers will be dedicated to each Zone to ensure spectators take their seats and avoid congestion during intermissions and exit following the game. Spectators are permitted to enter & exit the facility through their dedicated entrance at intermission if necessary</p> <p>Separation: Each Zone will have its own Entry/Exit, washrooms and concession and will be physically separated by pipe and drape barriers and caution tape. Ushers and security will also be on hand to understanding of entrances, washrooms and concessions .</p> <p>Seating: All tickets will be sold to ensure physical distancing between individual attendees allowing same household or known social groupings of up to 10 persons.</p>
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	<p>Washrooms: Each Zone will have a designated washroom clearly communicated at purchase, through Ushers, Security and Game announcements at breaks/intermissions</p>
<p>Contact Tracing</p>	<p>Captured by Junior A Mariners Leadership before each game:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sponsor Seats • Player Billet Seats • Participants - Home and Visiting Team (Players, Coaches & Support Staff) • Officials <p>Capture by Mariners Centre (at point of purchase)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Season Ticket Holder Seats • Open Ticket Sales for each game <p>All contact tracing detail to be retained for 21 days following event</p>
<p>Patron Declarations</p>	<p>All spectators will answer the following questions (declarations) at ticket purchase:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Is the person feeling unwell? • Have they traveled outside Atlantic Canada within the last 14 days? • Are they a close contact of a confirmed case of COVID-19? • Are they waiting for results of a COVID-19 test? • Are you self-isolating for any reason? <p>Ticket Takers will also ask the following at each entrance: “Has the contact tracing detail you provided and health questions you answered at</p>
<p>Food & Beverage</p>	<p>Canteens will be Zone Specific. At the writing of this document we will have a basic set-up of non-alcoholic beverages and snacks. Plexiglass will physically separate staff and floor markings will guide a socially distant line-up. Sanitization will take place between the handling of any money and food or beverage.</p>
